Draw a number line of 10 cm and mark out the tenths

e.g. 7, 7.1, 7.2, 7.38

Mark on your number with an arrow then round it to the nearest whole number e.g. 7.6 rounds to 8.

Do 5 of these. (Note that .5 rounds up).
