This half-term, we will be learning about the Islam religion in our RE lessons. To consolidate our learning, we have organised a trip to visit the Central Mosque in Leicester which will take place next half-term. We will have a guided tour around the mosque, learning more about the religion and the key features inside a mosque.

To make the most of our visit to Leicester we then plan to walk into town to see the Alice Hawkins Statue. We will be learning about Alice and her work as the leader of the suffrage movement in Leicester as part of our history topic this term. A few children have already visited the statue, but I know many more are keen to see it in real life too.

We will then take a walk to The Leicester Museum and Art Gallery which holds a vast array of exhibitions. We have a booked a room in the museum to eat our packed lunches.
