Year 6 Easter SATs Homework

As you are aware, SATs are rapidly approaching in Year 6 (W/C 12th May). When we arrive back to school after Easter there are just 2 weeks until the assessments - with May Day in the middle of that too!

All the children have been working incredibly hard all year and have made amazing progress as a result. To try and keep this momentum going, I have provided the children with some SATs revision to do over the Easter holidays.

The revision materials include maths, reading and SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) papers for the children to do, called '10 in 10'. These are designed to be done for 10 minutes each, over 10 days of the holiday. Therefore, your child should aim to revise for just half an hour each day to keep their learning fresh and revisit the skills they will need for both the SATs and for secondary school. I have also provided the answer sheets for each, so that you can go through the work with the children and support them if they need it. I have uploaded all of these onto the school website for you to access. It is under the 'Classes – Oak Class (Y6) - Easter Homework' tab.

Where possible, help your child whenever you feel is necessary - a good website that helps to explain some of the more technical terms is [Year 6 SATs revision worksheets PDF | TheSchoolRun](#). This website also has games and activities for children to have a go at if you wish.

It is important for all the children to keep their learning at the forefront of their minds to give them the chance to showcase their best selves in SATs; however, it is also important that they have a chance to relax, play and have fun! And let's not forget - eat lots of Easter eggs! I appreciate that you may have family plans and holidays scheduled in over the break and I do not expect your child to be completing any revision on those days. However, wherever you can fit any revision in I do believe will be beneficial for your child.
