Science

LO: Gather, record and present data in a variety of ways.

Find the heights of mountains around the world. You can use the
information sheets on the home learning tab and/or find some data of
your own.

Create a silhouette chart of mountains, illustrating scale by cutting out
and overlaying shorter mountains in front. Include the highest in the
world and some from the UK for comparison.

Draw them to scale but they don't have to be 100% accurate so
approximate!

Choose an easy scale e.g. 1000m = 10cm if you want to do a larger version.

1000m = 3cm will fit on A4 so Everest is 8848m = $8 \times 3 = 27$ cm and
Snowdon is 1085m = $1 \times 3 = 3$ cm
