Dear parents/ carers,

I'd like to welcome you all back to the final term of your child's time at Woodstone. If the spring term wasn't busy enough, the summer term is set to be even busier! We have the KS2 SATs starting on **Monday 13th May** before we begin the preparations for our leavers play and end of term activities.

In this letter you will find information about our homework expectations, PE days, KS2 SATS week, the SATs breakfast club and important dates for your diary.

Homework Expectations

Maths / English - We will continue to set homework assignments on Fridays and expect them to be returned the following Thursday. The homework set is designed to support children with their SATs revision, so it is important that they complete it.

Reading - Children are also expected to **read 3 times per week**, for a minimum of 20 minutes each time at home. Please ensure that any reading at home is recorded in your child's reading diary, this will be checked on Friday mornings.

TTRS – Children should also remember to complete **20 minutes** of TTRS practice at home each week. These sessions run from Friday afternoon to the following Friday morning.

Please note; we will stop setting the usual homework from Friday 10th May. However, children will be sent home with lines to rehearse for our leavers play.

PE

This half-term, we have **PE on Monday afternoons and Friday afternoons**. Please ensure that your child has both their indoor and outdoor kit with them all week as plans change at short notice.

The PE kit is an essential part of their uniform as it allows movement to be easier and more comfortable and is also designed to ensure health and safety guidelines are always adhered to. Please ensure that all PE kit items are named, check regularly that their kit fits (especially footwear), and includes:

- Outdoor: trainers suitable for playground and field, blue/black tracksuit bottoms / shorts, blue or white t-shirt, sweatshirt.
- Indoor: pumps, a blue or white t-shirt and blue shorts.

Long hair should be tied up during P.E. lessons. Jewellery and earrings must not be worn during P.E. lessons and should be removed by the children themselves. If your child cannot do this independently, please remove before this before the children come to school. Thank you.

KS2 SATs

This year, the KS2 SATs will take place between Monday 13th and Thursday 16th May. We'll be completing lots of additional work in school over the next few weeks in preparation for these. If you are concerned that your child is beginning to feel pressure about the assessments, then please don't hesitate to contact me and we will do our best to provide support at school. Remember, your child's mental health is our highest priority.

Breakfast Club

During the SATs week, we offer a free breakfast club for the Year 6 class in school. During this week, children are allowed to come to school early and have some breakfast and a drink with their peers. We've found this to be a brilliant way to relax the children before the assessments start. More details and reminders will follow before Friday 10th May.
