Plurals of Nouns

Is something is plural, it means that there's more than one of them.

Most plurals are really easy - you just add 's'. But if the word has one of the special endings (or, even worse, it ends with a 'y'), stop, take a deep breath, and remember these rules.

RULE #5

To make a word ending in 'f' or 'fe' plural, drop the 'f' or 'fe' and add 'ves'

e.g. thief = thieves



Take of 'f' and add 'ves'
