

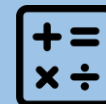


Art



In Art, this term, our focus will be on drawing. Where children will create more detailed and accurate shapes and forms. Children will also begin to experiment with shading, texture, and different materials to bring more expression and depth to their artwork.

Maths



This half term we will be studying:

- Multiplication and Division – Linking multiplication and division. Multiplying and dividing 2 digit numbers by a 1 digit numbers.
- Fractions

Computing



This half term we will learn what a simulation is and what it is used for. We will also be using Chrome Music Lab to combine technology and music – we will make our own rhythms and melodies.

Science



Our new topic in Science will be Plants. We will explore the requirements for life and growth and the role that flowers play in the lifecycle of plants.

P.E.



This half term we will begin Forest School on Wednesdays and Basketball on Thursdays. In Forest School we will be linking our Geography and Science learning by creating natural maps and surveying the different types of plants we can find.

Geography



This half term we will be learning about land use. Children will get the chance to take a careful look at the places around them, and begin to look for patterns in land use. They will become cartographers, making maps of the local area, and agricultural surveyors by considering where different types of farming activities occur within the UK.



English

Our first writing focus will be based on the story 'The Incredible Book Eating Boy' by Oliver Jeffers. The children will create their own narrative with a twist, writing a story about another incredible person. Then we will move on to create our own 'Summer is Here' poem.

We will also be having Whole Class Reading Sessions where we will focus on reading fluency, key spelling patterns and reading comprehension. Every Friday we will have a discrete grammar lesson, focusing on the skills needed for our current writing.

R.E.



In RE, we will be thinking about the question - How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jews? We will describe and make simple links between Jewish beliefs about God and his people and how Jews live through celebrating forgiveness, salvation and freedom at festivals.

Music



Technology, Structure and Form - In this unit children will learn the song: Oil in my lamp. The song will be analysed for its clear use of sections. Children will create their own class set of lyrics for the song as well as creating their own body percussion rhythms.
