
Understanding the world



Early Learning Goal

People and Communities

Children talk about past and present events in their own lives and in the lives of family members. They know that other children don't always enjoy the same things, and are sensitive to this. They know about similarities and differences between themselves and others, and among families, communities and traditions.

You can also access resources in Purple Mash by using the search tool in Purple mash and searching for the resources.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use the slideshows in both topics to talk to the children about the images.• Talk to the children about the things they like doing.• What makes them happy?• What makes them sad?• Do all the children in the class like doing the same thing?• Why do we all enjoy doing different things?• Do all your family like doing the same thing?• What happens somebody want to do something different?• How can we help to share the things that we do?• How can we help other children to enjoy the things that they do?• What do you think children living in other countries enjoy doing too?



- Think about all the different times we enjoy together, what kind of things do we do together?
 - Celebrate traditions, Christmas, Easter
 - Celebrate parties
 - Celebrate religious traditions.
