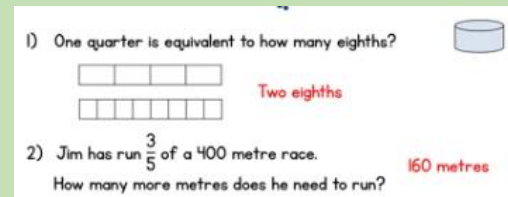

- Check the answers (The answers are under the activity)

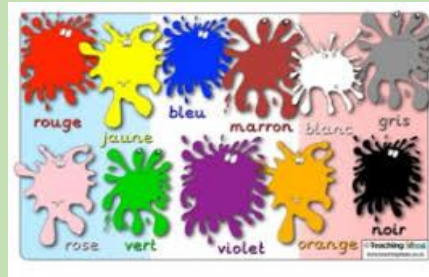
