Curriculum Vision Statement for PSHE

At Woodstone, we aim to create a happy, purposeful and supportive environment where children are empowered to become successful learners and achieve their full potential. Personal, Social, Health Education (PSHE) underpins our curriculum, enabling children to have the knowledge, understanding, skills and attitudes they need to lead confident, healthy, independent lives and to become informed, active and responsible citizens.

Our framework for PSHE embeds four strands: Healthy Lifestyles, Relationships, Citizenship and Economic Wellbeing as well as the statutory aspects of the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education guidance. In addition to these specific lessons, we strive to provide our children with learning opportunities across and beyond the curriculum including circle time, special school projects, trips and other activities that enrich pupils' experiences.

We encourage children to reflect on their experiences and understand how they are developing personally and socially, tackling many of the spiritual, moral, social and cultural issues that are part of growing up. They learn to understand and respect our common humanity, diversity and differences so that they can go on to form the effective, fulfilling relationships that are an essential part of life and learning. This is all reinforced through our teaching of the British Values - tolerance of different cultures & religions, democracy, rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect.
