In the Basket

Choose some objects at home to be pretend Easter eggs and have your own egg hunt.

Hide the eggs in the house or garden for someone else to find.

Time how long it takes for them to find the eggs.

Can you find the eggs in a faster time when it is your turn?



Egg and Spoon

Can you balance a ball on a large spoon or bat?

Can you move along with theball balanced?

Can you go around some obstacles?

Challenge someone at home to your own egg and spoon race.



Land on the Egg

Cut out the shape of an Easter egg to place on the floor.

Can you roll a ball to land on the Easter egg?

Can you move the egg further away?

Can you make the egg smaller?
