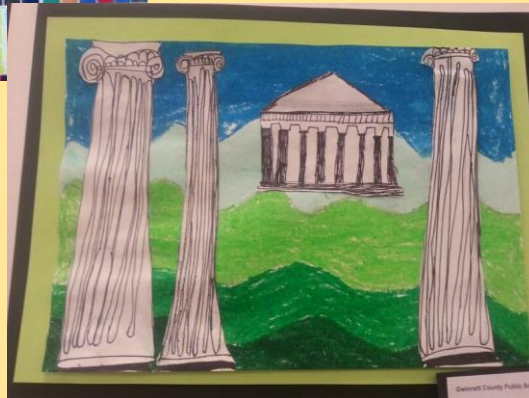
Compulsory Topic Task
