

Easter Maths Game

Year One, have a go at this game below. If you do not have access to a printer you could create your own at home on a blank piece of paper. If you do not have dice, you could write the numbers 1-6 twice on separate pieces of paper and then fold the paper so that you cannot see the numbers. Mix them up and then each player selects two pieces of paper on their turn ☺

Remember our trick to adding numbers - put the biggest number in your head and then count on the other number using your fingers.

Roll, add and colour!

INSTRUCTIONS;

1. Roll the dice
2. Add the numbers together
3. Colour the answer!

Two players:

Each player chooses a colour.
The winner is the one with the most Easter eggs in their colour at the end.
