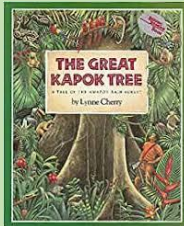
The Great Kapok Tree – Engage

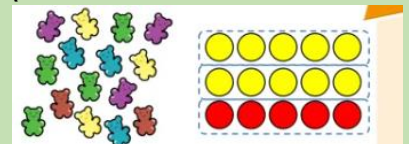

3. Stick the silhouette in the middle of the background

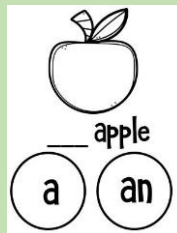


