



Art



This half term our focus in art is Printing. We will be looking at the artist Karen Lederer. The children will look at the concept of a repeated pattern and create their own printing block to create a pattern.

Science



For the Spring term we will be focusing on Animals including humans. The children will learn about nutrition, balanced diets, skeletons, muscles and different animal skeletons.



Geography



This term our topic is 'Mountains, Volcanoes and Earthquakes'. This will link into our Geography as we learn the layers of Earth and why natural disasters occur.



Music

This term our topic is 'Rhythm'. We will be exploring how rhythms can be created using syllable patterns and spoken phrases. We will continue to develop performing and composing skills.

Maths



This half term we will be studying:

- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division
- Money and Shape

Computing



This half term we will be learning the skill of touch typing and practicing this to improve our own typing abilities.

P.E.



This half term we will be doing Gymnastics and Hockey. In hockey the children will learn the basic principles of invasion games such as keeping possession of the ball and good teamwork. In gymnastics the children will look at movement and have a go at jumping, leaping, rolling and vaulting.



R.E.

This term's Islam topic looks at how festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim.



English

This half term our first unit will be based on the narrative 'The Secret of Black Rock' by Joe Todd-Stanton, before moving on to create a holiday brochure for Skara Brae!

We will also be having Whole Class Reading Sessions where we will focus on key spelling patterns and reading skills.

Every Friday we will have a discrete grammar lesson, focusing on the skills needed for our current writing.
