PE and Forest School

Reading, Phonics and Maths Homework

Please remember the children's phonics flashcards and their Monster Phonics book should be kept in their book bag every day. Thank you in your continued support in practising these regularly with your child as well as reading as least 5 times per week and recording this in your child's reading dairy.

The children will continue to visit the school library every week where they will be able to borrow books to take home. Please could you ensure the children's library books (these are the ones with the barcode inside























the front cover) are brought into school on a Wednesday so they can be changed during this weekly library slot.

We will be continuing to send home the weekly Maths Challenge work. Remember to return the Maths Challenge book on Wednesday for the new challenge to be sent out on Friday.
