## Pine Class (Year 3) Summer Term Letter

### Welcome back!

Welcome back after what we hope was a lovely Easter break for you and your families. The Pine Class team are looking forward to continuing to work hard with your children as we enter the final term of the year! We hope the children will come back to school refreshed and ready to continue learning!

### Forest School

This half term the children will be visiting the Forest on a Wednesday afternoon (starting Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> April). Children's Forest School kit will need to be in school on a Wednesday morning. Children will need waterproofs (jackets and trousers or all-in-one suit) and wellies which will stay in school. Layers are needed to go under the waterproofs. We advise children to wear leggings/jogging bottoms. Please ensure arms and legs are covered to avoid stinging nettles! **Please also ensure all kit is labelled with their name!**

### P.E.

Our PE lessons will be on a Thursday afternoon. Children will need **BOTH** an indoor and outdoor PE kit for these lessons and **they should remain in school all week and MUST be named**. Their kit should include:

**Outdoor:** trainers suitable for playground and field, tracksuit bottoms, blue or white t-shirt, sweatshirt.

**Indoor:** pumps, a blue or white t-shirt (preferably a Woodstone PE t-shirt) and blue or black shorts.

**Jewellery, including earrings, cannot be worn for any PE lessons.**

### Homework

-**Maths/Grammar:** This will continue to be given out on alternate Fridays and is due back in the following Thursday.

-**TTRS:** Times Tables Rock Stars. This will be set on a Friday after school for completion by the following Friday morning. Children are expected to play for 15 minutes each week, but it is up to them how they do this! This will be monitored and any children who have not completed it will be expected to do this in their own time at school. If there are any questions or concerns, please come and ask.

-**Reading:** Children are required to read at least 3 times per week, for a minimum of 15 minutes each time. We also strongly suggest you read to your children too as this is so beneficial to them. Please ensure any reading at home is recorded in your child's reading diary which will be checked on a Monday.

### Reminders



- Mrs Clinch will continue cooking with Pine class, she has three groups of children to cook with over the next couple of weeks.
  - Tuck shop is available at break times for your child to purchase a range of snacks, or alternatively you can provide your own snack for them to have. Please ensure any snacks sent into school are healthy (no crisps) and don't contain nuts.
  - We are seeing an increasing amount of toys/fidgets/lip balm being brought into school. Unless agreed by a member of staff, could you please ensure your child refrains from bringing such items into school. They are a distraction and most often than not they get lost and cause upset.
  - As the days get warmer, please ensure your child has sun cream applied at the start of the day, adults are unable to assist children in applying sunscreen and this can take away from learning time.
