The marine biome is the biggest biome in the world! It covers about 70% of the earth. It includes five main oceans: the Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Arctic, and Southern, as well as many smaller Gulfs and Bays. Because it is so big, you can concentrate your research into a chosen area if you wish for example: Coral reefs; one particular ocean; estuaries, where rivers meet the sea; the ocean bed or an idea of your own.
