Subject	Task

English	Today I'd like you to write the first <b>two</b> paragraphs of your story - <b>BUT NO MORE</b> . Make sure that you choose a good opening line (maybe a question?) and that you set the scene for your story. <i>Get into the action quite quickly and include effective and powerful detail. Your second paragraph is building up to 'the key moment' and will end with a cliffhanger and ellipses (...). Add to the drama in your story by varying the length of your sentences. Remember to check it through as you write. You will write the solution to the problem and the end of your story tomorrow so don't include any of that detail today.</i>
ILP - Beast Creator	Design and draw a bug hotel for some of the minibeasts that are native to the UK. Think about the suitable materials it could be made from (eg wood, plant pots, stones, vegetation), different levels, the different types of space and conditions each minibeast will need (wet, dry, dark, high, covered, etc). Draw it as neatly and accurately as you can, labelling each part clearly so anyone else building it could easily see what to do. You can build it tomorrow so check carefully for the possible materials first!
