

### Pine cone lardy seed feeders

### Recipe

100 g suet or lard, cut into small pieces and left in a warm place for about an hour.

A handful of sunflower and/or pumpkin seeds or special bird seed.

A handful of raisins\*.

Some grated cheese.

Some unsalted peanuts\*\*.

Place the ingredients in a bowl and squash them together with your hands.

\* Raisin warning - don't use if you have dogs.

\*\* Peanut warning - nut allergy, don't put whole peanuts out in breeding season.

- 1. After making your speedy bird cake mix, stuff some of it in the cracks of your pine cones.
- 2. Tie a string on to the pine cones to hang them up.
- 3. Hang the cones from a tree so that you can see them from your window.
