Year 3 - Creswell Crags 'Ice Age Caves' Trip

Dear Parents/ Carers,

On Friday 26th May 2023, the Year 3 class will be going on a school trip to the fantastic limestone caves at Creswell Crags!

Creswell Crags is a spectacular limestone gorge that straddles the border between Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire. It is dotted with a large number of caves, fissures and rock shelters, many of which harboured secrets from our Prehistoric past. It is home to the 'Church Hole', a world-famous cave containing examples of the oldest verified cave art in the UK, it was believed to have been inhabited by humans during the last Ice Age.

This trip will provide the Year 3 class with an engaging recap to last years 'Stone Age' topic and will give them the opportunity to see some of the things they've learned about up close.

We will take part in the 'Stone School' experience, further details of the trip's activities can be seen on the attached leaflet.

As the caves and some activities are outdoors, it is important that your child wears weather suitable clothing. Please ensure they have a warm coat and suitable footwear with a strong grip. The children do not need to wear uniform. We will be having lunch at the centre so the children will require a packed lunch and a drink. If you would like a free school packed lunch for your child, please indicate on the reply slip below.
