Main

Write 2 sentences for each homophone: there, their and they're. Write a short story of 50 to 100 words trying to use there, their and they're as many times as you can. Don't worry if it is silly/ nonsense - as long as you are accurate with the punctuation and spelling.

Maths

Starter - Use your digit card to make a 4 digit number e.g. 6394

Now round it to the nearest 1000. So 6394 rounds to 6000. Do 5 of these in your book.

Main - Add 4 digit numbers - use vertical addition with carrying above the line.

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Addition - Year 4} \\ 5247 \\ + 2394 \\ \hline 7641 \end{array}$$

Use your digit cards to make 5 calculations. For each one, write a number problem to match.
