**Common noun** = <u>person</u>, <u>place</u> or <u>thing</u> that doesn't need a capital letter e.g. *man*, shop, game, book, river.

**Proper noun** = <u>person</u>, <u>place</u> or <u>name</u> of something that starts with a capital letter e.g. *Millie*, Oxton, *Europa Swimming Pool*, *River Dee*.

Adjective = describing word

**Verb** = doing word (often ends in 'ing')
