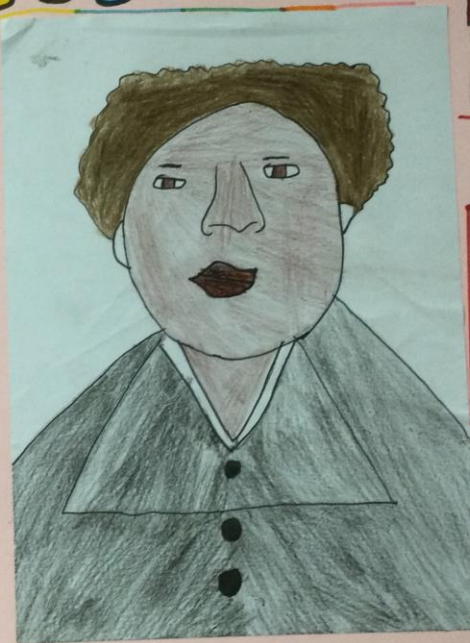
She was Born around 1820.

Harriet's real name was Araminta Harriet Ross. She had a very hard life working as a field hand in the plantation fields every day in the burning sun. She was often whipped and beaten. After this she suffered terrible headaches and developed narcolepsy, which she has for the rest of her life.

Harriet's Achievements

Harriet saved over 100 people. During the American Civil War, she became a nurse and a spy. She passed information onto Colonel Montgomery and became a leader of corps of local Black people.

HARRIET TUBMAN

Harriet used a network of secret routes known as 'Underground Railroad' to walk nearly 140 km to Pennsylvania.

She had very little money, so earned her living through selling Pies, gingerbread and root beer.

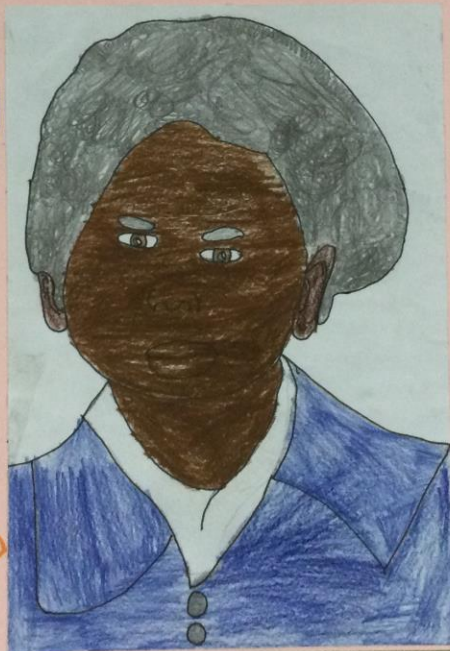
Born: Around 1820

Harriet saved over 1000 people during the American Civil War and then went on to be a nurse and spy.

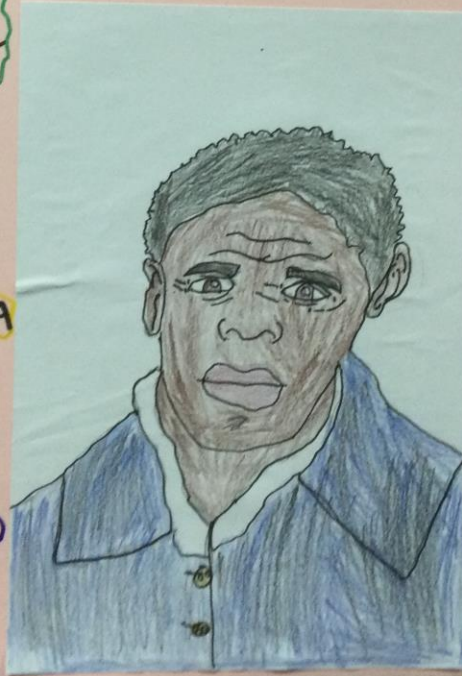
HARRIET TUBMAN

She had very little money, so earned her living through selling pies, gingerbread and root beer.

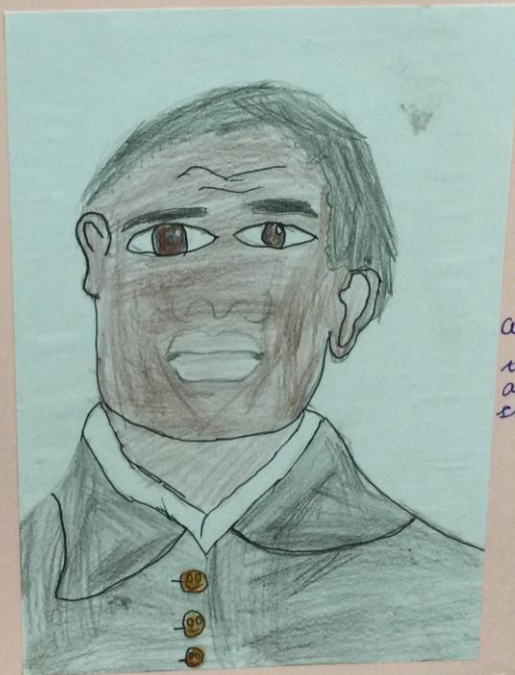
