You should be able to find  $\frac{1}{2}$  of all even numbers - are there any even numbers you cannot divide into quarters? I wonder if you can work out why?

### Science

Hopefully you had chance to complete your materials hunt on Monday. I would like you to use this information to investigate floating and sinking. Fill a bowl or the sink with water then predict which objects you think will float and which will sink. Do all objects made of the same material do the same thing? Record what you find out!
