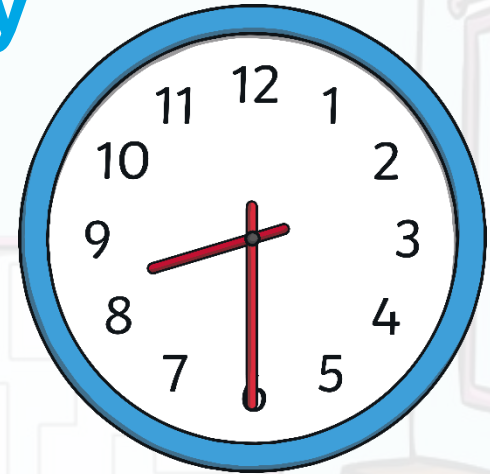

  - Feedback on homework is very useful 😊
- Spellings (see reading diaries)

You will find lots of useful information such as spellings and maths help sheets in the front and back of your child’s homework book.



# Reading

- Reading Vipers – See separate slide on the website (Also on bookmarks)
- We will be continuing with Monster phonics in Y2.
- Monster Phonics categorises the sounds into ten colour groups and each colour has a corresponding monster character – Sound mats are in homework books
- Children will read in a group week and individually with an adult at least once per week.
- Children will be able to borrow a book from the library every Friday
- Children will also have the opportunity to ‘borrow a book from Miss Barnes’



# Writing

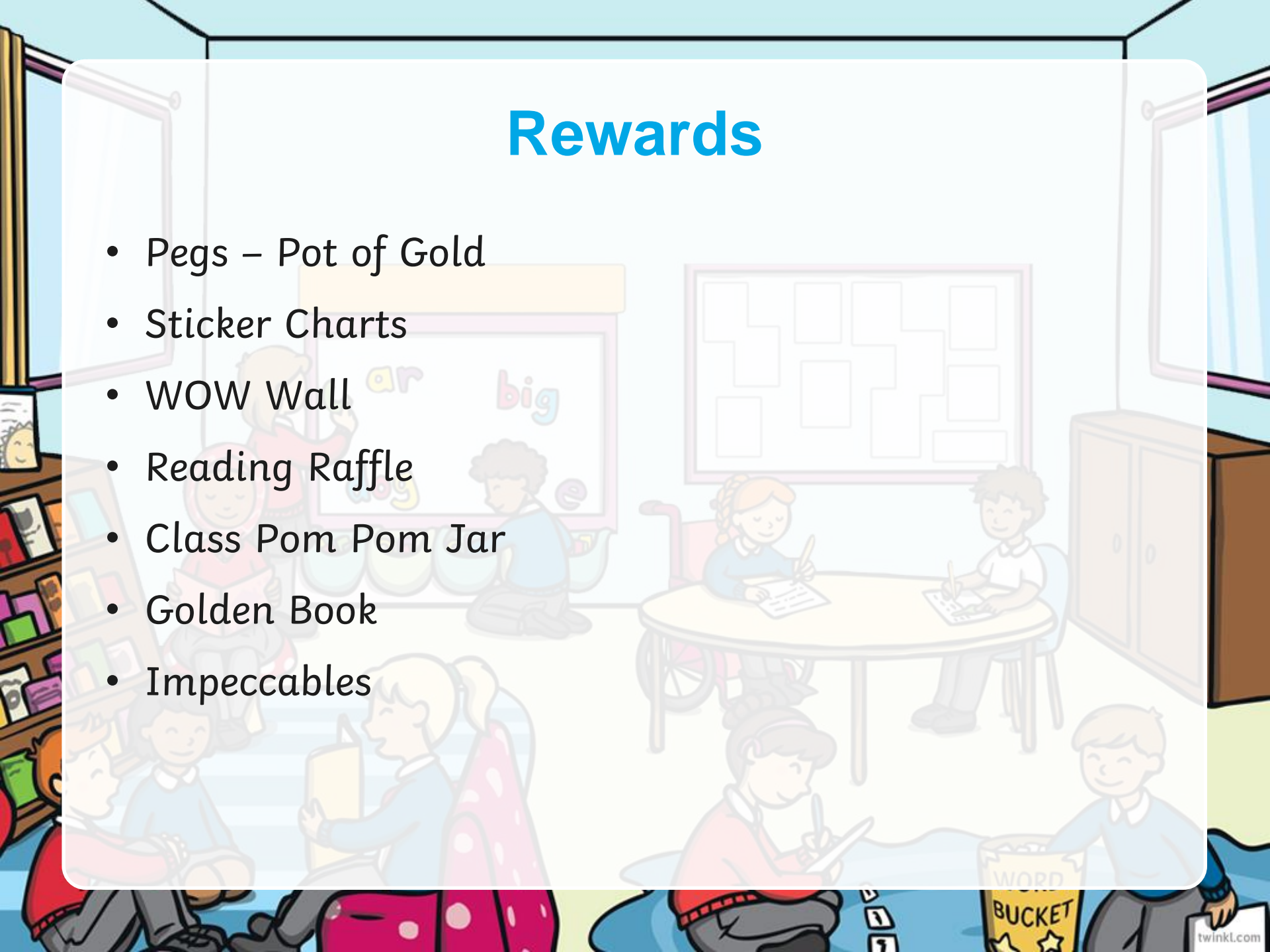
- We learn to join our letters in Year 2
- We will continue with our new writing scheme 'The Write Stuff'
- The scheme helps to scaffold writing by including more role modelling and sentence stacking. The scheme promotes vocabulary and coherence which children also get from reading.

# Assessments

- Children will complete school assessments each term to allow us to monitor progress
- Phonics Screening Check (Resit) will be held in June for those children who did not pass in Year 1.
