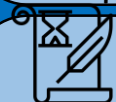


This half term we will be looking at printing. We will focus on repeating and overlapping shapes for effect and will spend time looking at both Pop Art and the artist, Andy Warhol.

Geography



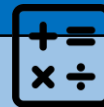
In our Geography lessons we will be looking at the topic Wonderful Weather. We will be learning about the weather and climate in the UK and in other countries of the world.

Maths



In Maths this half term we will develop our knowledge of place value moving on to teen numbers. We will also be focusing on addition and subtraction using these numbers, as well as continuing to practice doubling and number bonds.

English

Computing



In computing this half term we will be learning how to create our own animated stories using a variety of different software. We will also explore how to keep ourselves safe online.

In P.E. we will be developing our flexibility, rhythm and movement skills in gymnastics. This half term P.E. will be on a Tuesday afternoon.

R.E.
