English

Today you need to finish your story. First of all, read through what you wrote yesterday to make sure it makes sense when you continue writing.

Now the most exciting part! Describe the dilemma in an exciting way - what happens? How do you or the character feel? What do you do? Put in lots of detail to engage the reader.

If you want more than one thing to happen that's okay e.g. see a shark, get stuck in plants, losing oxygen... Don't go too mad though!

Next you need to describe the resolution - how do you survive/ solve your problem. You can solve it yourself or you can be rescued.

End - think of a way to sum up the experience and conclude the story - remember no-one is allowed to die!

Geography

You need to be able to name the 7 continents (North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Africa, Antarctica and Oceania).

You need to be able to name the 5 oceans (Atlantic Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Indian Ocean, Arctic Ocean and Southern Ocean).

Look at the map below and draw your own sketch map of the world and label the continents and oceans. You can colour it if you want to.
