Welcome back!

We would like to offer a warm welcome back to school after what we hope has been a lovely summer break for you all. We are excited to start a new academic year and be a part of your children's educational journey once more. Mrs Leaney will teach on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and Miss Clement a Thursday and Friday. Mrs Moore and Miss Davies will be supporting the team at various times during the week. Together, we strive to support your children to reach their potential successfully in Year 3.

P.E.

Our PE lessons will be on a Tuesday and Thursday afternoon. Children will need **BOTH** an indoor and outdoor PE kit for these lessons and **they should remain in school all week**. Their kit should include:

Outdoor: trainers suitable for playground and field, tracksuit bottoms, blue or white t-shirt, sweatshirt (all named please)

Indoor: pumps, a blue or white t-shirt (preferably a Woodstone PE t-shirt) and blue or black shorts (again all named please)

Jewellery, including earrings, must not be worn during PE lessons. If earrings cannot be removed, parents/carers must provide tape for their child to cover them before the lesson.

Homework

-Maths/Grammar: This will be given out on alternate Fridays and is due back in the following Thursday.

-TTRS: Times Tables Rock Stars. Your children will be given usernames and passwords to log on to this and shown how to log on both through the app and website. It will be set electronically by Miss Clement on a Thursday and due to be completed by the following Wednesday afternoon. Children are expected to play for 15 minutes each week, but it is up to them how they do this! This will be monitored and any children who have not completed it will be expected to do this in their own time at school. If there are any questions or concerns, please come and ask.

-Reading: Children are required to read at least 3 times per week, for a minimum of 15 minutes each time. We also strongly suggest you read to your children too as this is so beneficial to them. Please ensure any reading at home is recorded in your child's reading diary.

Snacks

In KS2, your child does not receive fruit as a snack at break time. There is a tuck shop run by our Year 6 children where the children can purchase a range of snacks, or alternatively you can provide your own healthy snack for them to have. The tuck shop isn't expensive so the children will not need a lot of money. Please send any money in a named purse/wallet.

Equipment

The school provides each child with a pencil case and all the equipment they need for learning. Therefore, we kindly ask that children do not bring pencil cases from home.

We are aware of how popular squishy toys and other small toys can be; however, please ensure that your child does not bring any toys to school. These items can often cause distress if they are lost and may lead to disagreements between children.
