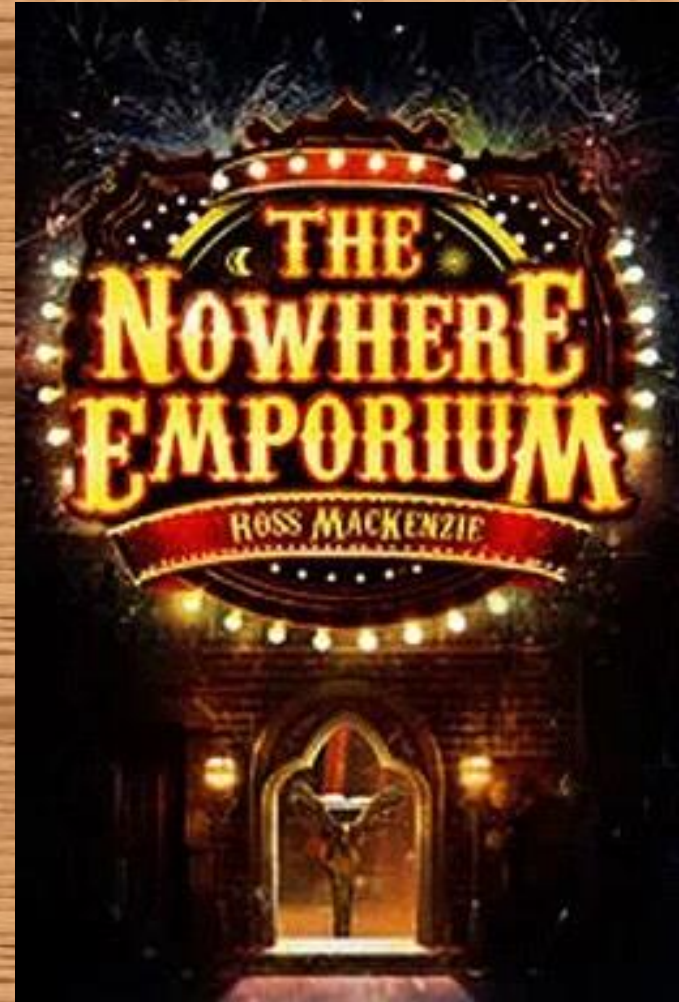


We have used The Nowhere Emporium to write our own sentences. Each sentence type has been written by a different child to make a sentence stack.
