Year 2 school closure arrangements

Dear Parents,

This is your child's workbook for the period of school closure. Please ensure the children complete all work set in this book, unless the activity is practical in which case there is no need to record anything. We have also included a hundred square, sound sheet and common exception word sheet which the children may find useful to use at home.

At this time of uncertainty it is important to keep as much of a routine as possible for the children. For this reason we will be setting work daily for the children and please support us in encouraging them to complete this. The work will be uploaded each day (Monday-Friday) by 9a.m. on the school website under the 'Home Learning 2020' tab down the right hand side of the home page. There will be a daily English and Maths activity as well as a wider curricular task. These will be linked to our 'Street Detectives' topic, as well as things we have been learning in our Science, Art and other wider curriculum lessons. We have also sent home the children's handwriting books as we will be setting daily spellings for the children to practise in these. Whilst SATs will now NOT take place in May, we have also included some practice SATs papers which are optional. Alongside this we will be providing some other suggested activities which the children may choose to complete at home.

There are number of educational websites who have temporarily made their content free for children to access from home whilst schools are closed. Please have a look at the 'General Learning Resources' tab on the 'Home Learning 2020' page for a list of these websites and how to access them.

Please continue to read regularly with your child. They will be bringing home a number of school reading books but when they have read these, Purple Mash have a number of E-books under the 'Serial Mash' tab with associated quizzes. The 'Diamond' books are aimed at age 5-6 and the 'Emerald' books are written for 7-9 year olds.

We will continue to keep you updated about the situation through the school website so please continue to check this regularly. There is a 'Coronavirus updates' tab on the 'Letters & Newsletters' section of the website where any new correspondence will be uploaded.

May I take this opportunity to wish you well during this difficult time. Whilst we endeavour to continue to educate the children in the best way we can given the circumstances, the most important thing is to look after each other and be mindful of our wellbeing during an uncertain time.
