Welcome back and a very happy New Year! We hope you had a wonderful Christmas. Thank you from all of the team for the cards, gifts and well-wishes – they are very much appreciated.

We are really looking forward to welcoming the children back for another exciting and busy term. Our topic this half term is '**Let's Share a Story**', where we will explore a range of traditional tales. After half term, we will be learning all about the continent of Africa through our '**Rumble in the Jungle**' topic. Please take a look at our curriculum map under the '**Classes**' tab on the school website to see some of the things we will be learning about this half term.

On **Wednesday 21st January**, we will be holding our first '**Share a Story**' session. Parents are invited to stay for half an hour at the beginning of the school day to share a story with their child (one parent per child, please). The session will finish by **9.30am**. We would love for you to join us if you are able to.

A few reminders for this half term:

- As we continue with our Phonics programme, it is really important that children practise their sound cards regularly and read **five times per week**. Please remember to record this in your child's reading diary. Children are rewarded for their efforts through our weekly Reading Raffle and Golden Book assemblies.
- Library sessions will continue on **Fridays**. Please ensure your child has their library book in school on this day.
- Forest School sessions will continue on **Thursday afternoons**. Please make sure your child has plenty of warm layers, including a hat, gloves and spare socks, while the weather is cold.
- The children will have **P.E. on Wednesdays** this half term, focusing on Gymnastics. However, please ensure your child has their P.E. kit in school all week in case of timetable changes. This should include a named pair of pumps and trainers.
